



### PARISH COUNCIL

The Annual Parish meeting was held on the 26<sup>th</sup> May, the Chair and Unitary Councillors presented their reports which are available to read on the Parish Council web site and Adrian Parsons official facebook page.

Other reports came from St Martins Church, Lewannick community Cinema and Polyphant Chapel, and Polyphant Ladies Club. This meeting was followed by the Annual Parish Council meeting where an election of the Chair and Vice Chair was carried out, Cllr Michael White has accepted the nomination of Chair and Cllr Carole Newbery has accepted the nomination of Vice Chair.

There was a short break for members of the public and Councillors to have "Tea and Cake" and talk about parish matters.

Then followed the ordinary Parish Council meeting.

A member of the public gave the Council a report about the Plush junction A30/B3257 which was gratefully received.

The Unitary Councillors report had previously been presented and is available on the official facebook page.

**Planning.** PA26/01850, Guenock House. A discussion was conducted where concerns over the Tree survey and Ecology assessment being out of date. Also, the location was questioned, this has been rectified on the Planning page as "Land East of Woodbery House" The council supported this application with a majority vote but noting that "An up-to-date Ecology Survey is required. PA26/02894 Land at Trewanta Hall Farm. This application was supported.

Lewannick Play area. The Zip wire has been repaired and inspected it is now fully functional, a new seat will be fitted soon. There has been a new pedestrian gate fitted. One of the picnic tables has been removed and will be replaced with a new one made from recycled plastic. The Mound is still awaiting repair as it is difficult to find someone willing to do the job.

Polyphant play area. A new picnic table will be ordered to replace the existing one. The broken rocker needs to be removed, we will ask our local handy man to do this.

Polyphant Green. The grass will be cut now that "No mow May". has come to an end.

Tree works are continuing to be progressed. The next meeting will be Tuesday 16th May in Lewannick.
